1. WHAT IS PODOSAL AND WHAT IS IT USED FOR?

The name of the medicine is PODOSAL.

PODOSAL OINTMENT active ingredient is Podophyllum 20% w/w and Salicylic acid 25%w/w.

PODOSAL PAINT active ingredient is Podophyllum 20% w/v.Podosal is indicated for treatment of warts

BEFORE YOU USE PODOSAL:

Do not use PODOSAL without medical advice:

If you have had an allergy to any ointments in the past

If you think you may be pregnant

In children without medical advice.

HOW TO USE PODOSAL:

Adults (including the elderly): A corn ring should be placed around the wart, cutting the ring to fit if necessary. A minimal amount of ointment should be applied to the exposed wart, taking care to avoid normal skin. The wart and corn ring should be covered with a plaster and the treatment repeated daily. When the wart appears soft and spongy, it should be left exposed and allowed to drop off. If the wart remains, the procedure should be repeated.

Plantar Warts: Use 2-3 times a week

Anogenital Warts: Use once a week

Children: Not recommended. Consult our doctor.

Care should be taken to prevent splashing of paint to surrounding skin If the condition does not improve in 3 days consult your doctor.

POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS:

You may find that your condition gets worse during treatment, you may be allergic to the preparation or have a skin infection. If this happens stop using the preparation and contact your doctor or pharmacist as soon as possible.

HOW TO STORE PODOSAL:

Do not use PODOSAL after the expiry date stamped on the tube and pack. The expiry date refers to the last day of the month.

Podosal should be stored in a cool, dry place (below 30° C).

Keep this medicine out of the sight and reach of children Medicines should not be disposed via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose medicines no longer required. These measures will help protect the environment.
