

Não tome Acyclovir Denk 200 durante a gravidez, a menos que o seu médico lhe diga para o fazer.

Não deve amamentar enquanto estiver a tomar Acyclovir Denk 200, a fim de evitar a infecção do seu bebé.

Doentes idosos

Os doentes idosos sofrem com maior frequência de compromisso da função renal. Por isso, recomenda-se verificar a função renal neste grupo de doentes e assegurar que são tomados líquidos suficientes com cada dose. Se necessário, o médico prescritor pode ajustar a dose (ver "Como tomar Acyclovir Denk 200").

Condução de veículos e utilização de máquinas

Até à data, o aciclovir não demonstrou ter qualquer efeito sobre a capacidade de conduzir e utilizar máquinas.

3. Como tomar Acyclovir Denk 200

Tome este medicamento exactamente como indicado pelo seu médico ou farmacêutico. Fale com o seu médico ou farmacêutico se tiver dúvidas.

A dose recomendada é:

Utilização em adultos

Para infecções por herpes simplex:

Uma dose única de 1 comprimido (200 mg de aciclovir) 5 vezes ao longo do dia em intervalos de 4 horas.

Para a profilaxia contra formas graves e muito recorrentes de infecções por herpes simplex genital:

Acyclovir Denk 200 deve ser administrado o mais cedo possível após a ocorrência dos primeiros sintomas de infecção. Particularmente em casos de infecções por herpes simplex recorrentes, o medicamento deve ser tomado aos primeiros sinais de uma infecção renovada (ou seja, comichão, tensão, primeiras vesículas).

Duração do tratamento

Como todos os medicamentos, este medicamento pode causar efeitos secundários, embora estes não se manifestem em todas as pessoas. A frequência dos efeitos secundários é classificada da seguinte forma:

Muito frequentes:	podem afectar mais de 1 em 10 pessoas
Frequentes:	podem afectar até 1 em 10 pessoas
Pouco frequentes:	podem afectar até 1 em 100 pessoas
Raros:	podem afectar até 1 em 1000 pessoas
Muito raros:	podem afectar até 1 em 10.000 pessoas
Desconhecida:	a frequência não pode ser calculada com base nos dados disponíveis

4. Efeitos secundários possíveis

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Utilização em crianças e adolescentes

Para o tratamento de infecções por *herpes simplex*, é administrada uma dose de adulto a crianças com mais de 2 anos de idade e metade da dose de adulto a crianças com menos de 2 anos de idade.

Se tomar mais Acyclovir Denk 200 do que deveria

Não se espera toxicidade após a sobredosagem com Acyclovir Denk 200. Não se desenvolvem sintomas de toxicidade após uma dose única de aciclovir. Não está disponível informação sobre doses únicas mais elevadas. Em caso de sobredosagem e no caso de ocorrerem mais efeitos secundários, ou caso tenha dúvidas, consulte o seu médico.

Caso se tenha esquecido de tomar Acyclovir Denk 200

Não tome uma dose a dobrar para compensar uma dose que se esqueceu de tomar. Continue o tratamento conforme lhe foi prescrito.

Caso se tenha esquecido de várias doses ou caso não tenha tomado Acyclovir Denk 200 suficiente, consulte o seu médico.

6. Conteúdo da embalagem e outras informações

Qual a composição de Acyclovir Denk 200

- A substância activa é aciclovir. Cada comprimido contém 200 mg de aciclovir.
- Outros componentes são celulose microcristalina, glicolato de amido de sódio, povidona K25, sílica coloidal anidra, estearato de magnésio, amido de milho.

Classificação quanto à dispensa ao público

- aumentos em determinados resultados de análises ao sangue (valores hepáticos, valores renais, pigmento biliar, ureia)

Qual o aspecto de Acyclovir Denk 200 e conteúdo da embalagem

Comprimidos brancos, redondos, biconvexos.

1. What Acyclovir Denk 200 is and what it is used for

For the treatment of herpes simplex infections, the adult dose is given to children over 2 years and half the adult dose to children below 2 years.

If you take more Acyclovir Denk 200 than you should

- diminuição do número de glóbulos vermelhos ou brancos, diminuição do número de plaquetas
- falência renal aguda, dor renal
- inflamação do fígado (hepatite), icterícia

As reações alérgicas graves (reações anafiláticas, angioedema, dispneia) são raras.

2. What you need to know before you take Acyclovir Denk 200

Elderly people

Elderly patients suffer more frequently from impaired kidney function. It is therefore recommended, to check the kidney function in this group of patients and to ensure, that sufficient liquid is taken with each dose. If required, the prescribing physician may adjust the dose (refer to "How to take Acyclovir Denk 200").

If you forget to take Acyclovir Denk 200

Do not take a double dose to make up for a forgotten dose. Continue treatment as prescribed.

If you have forgotten several doses or have not taken enough Acyclovir Denk 200, please consult your doctor.

Driving and using machines

To date, aciclovir has not been shown to have any effect on the ability to drive and use machines.

Warnings and precautions

Talk to your doctor or pharmacist before taking Acyclovir Denk 200.

Method of administration

The tablets should be swallowed whole with adequate liquid (one glass of water) after meals.

3. How to take Acyclovir Denk 200

Always take this medicine exactly as your doctor or pharmacist has told you. Check with your doctor or pharmacist if you are not sure.

The recommended dose is:

Use in adults

For herpes simplex infections:

One single dose of 1 tablet (200 mg aciclovir) 5 times throughout the day at intervals of 4 hours.

For prophylaxis against severe forms and very frequently recurring genital herpes simplex infections:

Very common:	may affect more than 1 in 10 people
Common:	may affect up to 1 in 10 people

Not known:	frequency cannot be estimated from the available data

4. Possible side effects

Like all medicines, this medicine can cause side effects, although not everybody gets them. The frequency of side effects is classified as follows:

Very common:	decrease in the number of red or white blood cells,
Common:	decrease in the number of platelets
Uncommon:	acute kidney failure, kidney pain
Rare:	liver inflammation (hepatitis), jaundice

Other medicines and Acyclovir Denk 200

Tell your doctor or pharmacist if you are taking, have recently taken or might take any other medicines.

The effect of Acyclovir Denk 200 will be prolonged if you are also taking

- probencide (used to treat high uric acid levels in the blood)
- cimetidine (used to reduce stomach acid production)
- mycophenolate mofetil (used to prevent transplant rejection reactions).

However, no dose adjustment is necessary.

Reporting of side effects

If you get any side effects, talk to your doctor or pharmacist. This includes any possible side effects not listed in this leaflet. See section 4.

5. How to store Acyclovir Denk 200

- Keep this medicine out of the sight and reach of children.
- Do not use this medicine after the expiry date which is stated on the carton and blister strip after "Exp". The expiry date refers to the last day of the month.

Pregnancy and breast-feeding

If you are pregnant or breast-feeding, think you may be pregnant or are planning to have a baby, ask your doctor or pharmacist for advice before taking this medicine.

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Do not take a double dose to make up for a forgotten dose. Continue treatment as prescribed.

6. Contents of the pack and other information

Pharmacodynamic properties

Pharmacotherapeutic group: guanosine analogue, antiviral, viral DNA polymerase inhibitor
ATC code: J05AB01

Aciclovir is a pharmacologically inactive substance which does not become an antiviral agent until after penetration into a cell infected with herpes simplex viruses (HSV) or varicella zoster viruses (VZV). This activation of aciclovir is catalysed by HSV- or VZV thymidine kinase, an enzyme that viruses particularly need for their replication.

In simple terms, one can say that the virus synthesizes its own antiviral agent.

In more detail, the following steps occur:

- a) Aciclovir preferentially penetrates herpes-infected cells.
- b) The viral thymidine kinase present in these cells phosphorylates aciclovir to aciclovir monophosphate.
- c) Cellular enzymes convert aciclovir monophosphate to aciclovir triphosphate, the actual antiviral agent.
- d) Aciclovir triphosphate has a 10-30 times greater affinity to viral DNA polymerase than cellular DNA polymerase and hence selectively inhibits activity of the viral enzyme.

e) Furthermore, the viral DNA polymerase incorporates aciclovir into the viral DNA, resulting in a chain termination during DNA synthesis.

Overall, these individual steps lead to a highly effective reduction in viral production.

Pharmacokinetic properties

Absorption

Aciclovir is only partially absorbed from the gastrointestinal tract. After repeated oral administration of 200 mg, 400 mg and 800 mg aciclovir at an interval of 4 hours 5 times a day, mean peak plasma levels determined at steady state are $3.02 \pm 0.5 \mu\text{mol/l}$ (200 mg), $5.21 \pm 1.32 \mu\text{mol/l}$ (400 mg) and $8.16 \pm 1.98 \mu\text{mol/l}$ (800 mg), respectively. These values are reached after about 1.5 ± 0.6 hours. The corresponding plasma baseline values are respectively $1.61 \pm 0.3 \mu\text{mol/l}$ (200

mg), $2.59 \pm 0.53 \mu\text{mol/l}$ (400 mg) and $4.0 \pm 0.72 \mu\text{mol/l}$ (800 mg) about 4 hours after oral administration of aciclovir. 24 hours after discontinuation of aciclovir tablets, aciclovir is no longer detectable in the body.

Distribution

Animal trials confirm that, compared to the serum level, higher aciclovir levels are reached in the intestines, kidney, liver and lung, whilst lower levels are reached in the muscle, heart, brain, ovaries and testes of the animals.

Post-mortem investigations in humans have revealed that aciclovir accumulates in saliva, vaginal secretions, in the vesicular fluid of herpes blisters and some organs. 50% of the corresponding serum concentrations are reached in the cerebrospinal fluid.

Biotransformation and elimination

In patients with healthy kidneys, aciclovir is renally eliminated in unchanged form (62–91%) and as 9-carboxymethoxy methyl guanine (10–15%). After IV administration of aciclovir, plasma half-lives ($t_{1/2}$) of 2.87 ± 0.76 hours were determined for adults and 4.1 ± 1.2 hours for neonates and infants up to 3 months.

Aciclovir undergoes both glomerular filtration and tubular secretion. If aciclovir is given one hour after administration of 1 g probenecid, the plasma half-life ($t_{1/2\alpha}$) is prolonged by 18% and the area under the plasma concentration-time curve is increased by 40%. With a bioavailability of about 20%, approximately 80% of the total aciclovir dose is excreted with the faeces.

Utilisation chez les adultes

Infections à l'herpès simplex :

Une dose unique de 1 comprimé (200 mg d'aciclovir) 5 fois pendant la journée, toutes les 4 heures.

Si vous avez d'autres questions sur l'utilisation de ce médicament, demandez plus d'informations à votre médecin ou à votre pharmacien.

De plus, les effets secondaires suivants peuvent survenir

- probénécide (médicament réservé au traitement de taux élevés d'acide urique dans le sang),
- cimétidine (médicament destiné à réduire la production d'acide gastrique),
- mycofenolate mofétol (médicament pour éviter les réactions de rejet après une transplantation d'organe).

Il n'est toutefois pas nécessaire d'ajuster la dose.

Durée du traitement

C'est le médecin traitant qui décidera de la durée du traitement.

En cas d'infections à l'herpès simplex, la durée du traitement est de 5 jours, mais il peut toutefois être prolongé en fonction de l'état clinique du patient.

En cas de grossesse, la durée du traitement est de 10 à 14 jours. La fréquence des effets indésirables est définie comme suit :

Très fréquent : peuvent toucher plus de 1 personne sur 10

Fréquent : peuvent toucher jusqu'à 1 personne sur 10

Peu fréquent : peuvent toucher jusqu'à 1 personne sur 100

Rare : peuvent toucher jusqu'à 1 personne sur 1 000

Très rare : peut toucher jusqu'à 1 personne sur 10 000

Fréquence indéterminée : ne peut être estimée sur la base des données disponibles
