

Opele lotion is a viscous white lotion that possesses powerful antipendicular and antiscabious properties against <u>pediculus humans</u> of both <u>capitis</u> and <u>carpori</u> variety causing head louse and body louse in humans.

It is active against <u>sarcoptes scabies</u>, the causative agent of scabies in man. **Composition:** Opele lotion contains 25% w/v Benzyl Benzoate in emulsion form.

Action: Ectoparasiticidal preparation.

Indication: Treatment of scabies and pediculosis and as an insect repellant. **Dosage and Administration:** After a light scrub all over preferably in a hot bath to open up burrows, immediately after drying, Opele lotion is applied using cotton wool or a clean cloth on the entire body below the head. The process is repeated every 12 hours for four consecutive days.

In the case of a family member contracting scabies or pediculosis, it is recommended that all family members should apply the lotion on the whole body for preventive purposes.

Opele is also used as an insect repellant. Clothes and bedding should be soaked in a diluted solution. (1 bottle of Opele in a bucket of water).

Precaution: If applied to the scalp, the eyes must be protected

Warning: For external use only.

Adverse Reactions: Opele may cause skin irritation and temporary burning sensation that may be an indication for diluting the lotion for the next application.

Poisoning: If accidentally taken by mouth, seek medical advice immediately. **Treatment:** (Poisoning) Should consist of gastric lavage or administration of an emetic. An anticonvulsant should be given if necessary, otherwise treatment is symptomatic.

Caution: Keep medicines out of reach of the children.
