**1 WHAT IS ZEDCAL ORAL SUSPENSION AND WHAT IS IT USED FOR**

ZEDCAL ORAL SUSPENSION IS recommended for:

- Growing children.
- Adolescents and young adults.
- Pregnant and breast-feeding women.
- Post-menopausal women.
- Elderly men.

**2. WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW BEFORE YOU TAKE ZEDCAL ORAL SUSPENSION**

Zedcal Oral Suspension is contraindicated for

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Diseases and/or conditions resulting in hypercalcaemia and/or hypercalciuria (e.g. myeloma, bone metastases, primary hyperparathyroidism).

- Nephrolithiasis / nephrocalcinosis
- Severe renal impairment and renal failure

**3. HOW TO TAKE ZEDCAL ORAL SUSPENSION**

As directed by the Physician.

**If you take more Zedcal Oral Suspension than you should**

It is important not to take doses. If you have taken more than you should, contact your doctor, pharmacist or nearest hospital casualty department immediately.

**If you forget to take Zedcal Oral Suspension**

If you forget to take your syrup, take it as soon as you remember, unless it is nearly time for your next dose; do not take the dose you have missed. Do not take a double the dose to make up for a forgotten dose.

**4. POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS**

Stomach upset, loss of appetite, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, allergic skin rashes, lower blood pressure

**5. HOW TO STORE ZEDCAL ORAL SUSPENSION**

Protect from direct exposure to light.

Store below 30°C, at a dry place

Keep medicines out of reach of children.

**6. CONTENTS OF THE PACK AND OTHER INFORMATION**

**What Zedcal Oral Suspension contains**

The active substance is Calcium, Magnesium, Zinc and Vitamin D3

**What Zedcal Oral Suspension looks like and contents of the pack**

White to off white, sweet viscous easily redispersible suspension with characteristic orange peppermint flavor pack in a 200ml PET bottle packed in a secondary carton along with an insert.
