1 WHAT IS ZITHROCARE TABLET AND WHAT IS IT USED FOR

1. Upper Respiratory Tract Infections
2. Otitis Media
3. Lower Respiratory Tract Infections
4. Skin and Soft Tissue Infections
5. Sexually Transmitted diseases, especially genital Chlamydia infections
6. Mycobacterium avium intracellular complex infections in AIDS
7. Other sensitive infections

2. WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW BEFORE YOU TAKE ZITHROCARE TABLET

1. Hypersensitivity to Azithromycin or any of the macrolide antibiotics
2. Co-administration with ergot derivatives

3. HOW TO TAKE ZITHROCARE TABLET

As directed by the Physician. Tablets for oral administration.

If you take more Zithrocare Tablet than you should

It is important not to take doses. If you have taken more than you should, contact your doctor, pharmacist or nearest hospital casualty department immediately.

If you forget to take Zithrocare Tablet

If you forget to take your tablet, take it as soon as you remember, unless it is nearly time for your next dose; do not take the dose you have missed. Do not take a double the dose to make up for a forgotten dose.

4. ADVERSE REACTION:

No severe or irreversible adverse effects have been reported.

5. HOW TO STORE ZITHROCARE TABLET

Protect from direct exposure to light.

Store below 30°C, at a dry place

Keep medicines out of reach of children.

6. CONTENTS OF THE PACK AND OTHER INFORMATION

What Zithrocare Tablet contains

The active substance is **Azithromycin dihydrate USP**
