### AGODOX

Doxycycline Capsules BP 100 mg.

**Composition :**

Each Capsule contains:

Doxycycline Hyclate BP equivalent to 100 mg.

Anhydrous Doxycycline.

Excipients q.s.

Approved colour used in capsule shells.

**Introduction :** Agodox is a tetracycline with bacteriostatic properties against a wide range of organisms including Gram-positive organisms such as Staphylococci, Streptococci, Actinomyces, Bacillus anthracis, Listeria monocytogenes; Anaerobes like Clostridia spp., Nocardia spp., and Propionibacterium spp., Brachyella, Catarrhals, Bordetella, Pertussis, Brucella spp., Campylobacter spp., Haemophilus, Influenzae, Legionella, pasteurella, maltocida and Enterobacteriaceae. Doxycycline is also effective against Chlamydia, rickettsia, Helicobacter pylori and also certain protozoa.

AGODOX probably acts by interfering with protein synthesis and hence cell growth in microorganisms.

**Indication:** AGODOX sensitive infections such as respiratory, genitourinary, dental, ophthalmic - ENT infections; rickettsial infections, chlamydial infections, typhus, spotted fevers, acne vulgaris, trench fever, trachoma, psittacosis, non - cholera (along with oral rehydration therapy), pelvic inflammatory disease, mylriadosis, and along with streptomycin in brucellosis.

AGODOX is used as an alternative to other antibiotics in animal bites, traveller's diarrhoea, anthrax, bronchitis, gastro-Enteritis. Agodox is used along with quinine in chloroquine-resistant falciparum malaria.

**Dosage:** Adults: 700 mg on the first day followed by 100 mg daily.

Children: 4 mg/kg / day initially followed by 2 mg / kg / day.

**Adverse Reactions :** Tooth discolouration, enamel hypoplasia, reduced fibula growth rate, nausea, vomiting, Diarrhoea, dry mouth, glossitis, dysphagic and oesophageal Ulceration. Prolonged use can lead to oral candidiasis, vulvo-Vaginitis, pruritus ani, and uraemia. Hypersensitivity Reactions can also occur.

**Precaution & Contraindications:** Hypersensitivity, pregnancy, Lactation and renal impairment are contraindications to the Use of AGODOX. To be given with caution in Presence of Hepatic dysfunction.

**Storage:**

Store under normal storage conditions (15°C-30°C)

Protect from light.

Keep all medicines out of reach of children.

**Presentation :** Blister pack of 10 x 10 & 100 X 10 capsules for Pack of 1000 Capsules.
