### 1.5.3 Patient information leaflet (PIL)

dyscrasias have occurred after both short term and prolonged therapy. Chloramphenicol must not be used when less potentially dangerous agents are effective. It must not be used in treatment of trivial infections, infections other than those indicated or as a prophylactic agent to prevent bacterial infection.

#### Interactions:

Rifampicin, Warfarin, Sulphonylureas, phenobarbitol, Phenytoin, Cyclosporin, Lacrolimus.

#### Adverse effects:

Blood disorders including reversible and irreversible aplastic anaemia (with reports of resulting leukaemia), peripheral neuritis, optic neuritis, erythema multiforme, nausea, vomiting, glossitis, stomalitis, diarrhoea, nocturnal haemoglobinuria reported; grey syndrome (abdominal istension, pallid cyanosis, circulatory collapse) may follow excessive doses in neonates with immature hepatic metabolism.

Store under normal storage conditions (15°C-30°C) Protect from light. Keep medicines out of reach of children.
