

Dosage: Adults: One to Two tablets four times a day

Antacids, corticosteroids, urinary alkalinizers May decrease aspirin levels.

Heparin, oral anticoagulants May increase risk of bleeding.

Drug Interactions: Alcohol May increase risk of GI ulceration and prolong bleeding time.

Carbonic anhydrase inhibitors (eg, acetohexamide), methotrexate, valproic acid May increase levels of these drugs.
