AMILINE TABLETS

(AMITRIPTYLINE TABLETS BP 25 MG)

APPEARANCE:

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A pink coloured, circular biconvex film coated tablet, plain on both side.

CATEGORY: Antihistamine

CLINICAL PHARMACOLOGY:

LLINICAL PHARMACOLOGY:Amitriptyline is a potent inhibitor of noradrenaline re-uptake at nonadrenergic nerve endings. It is also a potent inhibitor of 5-hydroxytryptamine (Serotonin). It has antagonist effects at muscarinic acetylcholine, receptors. It blocks muscarinic cholinergic receptors in the CNS & in the periphery. It also has affinity for Histamine H₁ receptors.

CONTRAINDICATIONS: Myocardial Infarction, arrythmias, congestive cardial failure, coronary artery insufficiency, mania, severe liver disease.

DOSAGE & ADMINISTRATION: Initially 75 mg in divided doses increasing to 150 mg daily.

Children: 6-10 yrs. : 10-20 mg at bed time. Over 11 yrs. : 25-50 mg at bed time.

ADVERSE EFFECTS:
Cardiac arrythmias, severe hypotension & confusion occur at high doses. Dry mouth, tachycardia, disturbances of accommodation, constipation & hesitancy of micturition. Nausea, vomiting, sweating, postural hypertension, dizziness, tremor, rashes, interference with sexual function.

INTERACTION:

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Barbiturates & other enzyme inducers such as rifampicin & some antiepileptics can increase the metabolism of Amitryptyline & may result in lowered plasma concentration & reduced antidepressant response cimetidine, methylphenidate, antipsychotics & calcium. Channel blocker may reduce the metabolism of Amitryptyline leading to possibility of increased plasma cone & accompanyingtoxicity.

Storage: Store under normal storage conditions (15°C to 30°C).

Protect from Light.

Keep all medicines but of reach of children.
