ZINC OXIDE OINTMENT USP 20%W/W

Composition:

Each gram contains:

Zinc Oxide USP .. 200 mg

Ointment base q.s.

Clinical Pharmacology:

Zinc oxide is a topical skin product that is used as a protective coating for mild skin irritations and abrasions. It can promote the healing of chapped skin and diaper rash. Zinc Oxide works as a mild astringent and has some antiseptic properties.

Indication:

Zinc oxide topical (for the skin) is used to treat diaper rash, minor burns, severely chapped skin, or other minor skin irritations. Provides soothing relief from poison ivy, oak and sumac.

Precautions:

You should not use zinc oxide topical if you are allergic to zinc, dimethicone, lanolin, cod liver oil, petroleum jelly, parabens, mineral oil, or wax.

Zinc oxide topical will not treat a bacterial or fungal infection. Call your doctor if you have any signs of infection such as redness and warmth or oozing skin lesions.

Ask a doctor before using this medicine if you are pregnant or breast feeding.

Uses:

Helps treat and prevent diaper rash. Protects chafed skin due to

diaper rash and helps seal out wetness.
Dries the oozing and weeping of poison ivy, poison oak and poison sumac.

Warnings:

- For external use only.
- When using this product, avoid contact with the eyes.
- Stop use and ask a doctor if condition worsens or does not improve within 7 days.

Directions: apply liberally as often as necessary.

For diaper rash:

- Change wet or soiled diapers promptly.
- Cleanse the diaper area and allow to dry.
- Apply ointment liberally, as often as necessary, with each diaper change and especially at bedtime or anytime when exposure to wet diapers may be prolonged.

STORAGE:

Store under normal storage condition (15°C to 30°C).

Protect from light.

Keep all medicines out of reach of children.
