1. WHAT IS BIOFULVIN 500MG TABLETS AND WHAT IS IT USED FOR?

The name of the medicine Biofulvin 500mg Tablets which is an antifungal antibiotic that is active *in vivo* against common dermatophytes. The antifungal effect is manifested by binding to tubulin, at distinct binding sites, thus interfering with the microtubule function and causing inhibition of mitosis, and arresting cell division.

The inhibition of fungal mitosis leads to the production of multinucleate cells of characteristic morphology.

On entering the systemic circulation, griseofulvin binds to keratin in keratin precursor cells, thereby making them resistant to fungal infections. The drug only reaches the site of action when hair or skin is replaced by the keratingriseofulvin complex.

Griseofulvin then enters the dermatophyte through energy dependent transport processes and binds to the fungal microtubules, interfering with, and inhibiting mitosis, and the deposition of fungal cell walls.

Each tablet contains:

Griseofulvin B.P 500mg.

2. BEFORE YOU USE BIOFULVIN 500MG TABLETS:

- Do not use Biofulvin 500mg Tablets without medical advice.
- Do not use Biofulvin 500mg Tablets if got hepatic impairment, systemic Lupus Erythematosus, Sexually active men and also women using contraceptives.

3. HOW TO USE BIOFULVIN 500MG TABLETS:

Biofulvin 500mg Tablets are taken orally. Tablets are swallowed whole with a glass of water and is recommended to be taken with a high fat meal, for increased absorption and minimizing GI distress.

4. POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS:

Like all medicines, Biofulvin 500mg Tablets can have side effects which include the following:

Blood and lymphatic system disorder, nervous system disorder, gastrointestinal disorders, Hepatobiliary disorders, Skin and subcutaneous tissue disorders.

5. HOW TO STORE BIOFULVIN 500MG TABLETS.

Do not use Biofulvin 500mg Tablets after the expiry date stamped on the pack. The expiry date refers to the last day of the month.

Biofulvin 500mg Tablets should be stored below 30°C in a cool dry place. Protect from direct sunlight.

Medicines should not be disposed of via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose of medicines no longer required. These measures will help protect the environment.


