COLDAMOL ORAL PREPARATIONS:

Paracetamol, Chlorpheniramine maleate, Caffeine anhydrous and Pseudoephedrine

Read this leaflet carefully before you start taking this medicine.

- If you have any further questions, please ask your doctor or pharmacist.
- Do not pass this medicine on to others. It may harm them, even if their symptoms are the same as yours.
- In order that this medicine works, it must be taken exactly as directed.
- Keep all medicines out of reach of children.

1. WHAT IS COLDAMOL AND WHAT IS IT USED FOR?

The name of the medicine is Coldamol. The active ingredients is Paracetamol, Chlorpheniramine maleate, Caffeine anhydrous and Pseudoephedrine.

Coldamol is indicated for symptomatic relief of cold and flu like symptoms.e.g stuffed up nose, runny nose, sneezing, watery eyes, sinuses pain and fever.

Each capsule contains:

Chlorpheniramine maleate ---- 4.0mg
Caffeine anhydrous-----30mg
Pseudoephedrine HCl-----, 30mg
Paracetamol-----400mg

Each 5mls contains

Chlorpheniramine maleate ---- 2.0mg
Pseudoephedrine HCl----- 10mg
Paracetamol-----120mg

2. BEFORE YOU USE:

Do not use Coldamol without medical advice:

- If you have had an allergy to any of the ingredients in the past.
- If you are on any other drugs.

3. HOW TO USE COLDAMOL:

Capsules

Adults: 1 capsule (3-4) times daily

Syrup:

Children's: 6 – 12 years (1-2) 5ml spoonful 3-4 times daily

2-6 years one 5ml spoonful 3times daily

4. POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS:

Like all medicines, Coldamol can have side effects though not everyone gets them.

- Drowsiness and impair performance in tests of auditory vigilance.

Report this or any other side effects to your doctor or pharmacist.

5. HOW TO STORE COLDAMOL:

Do not use Coldamol after the expiry date stamped on the pack. The expiry date refers to the last day of the month.

Coldamol should be stored in a cool place below 30°C, protected from direct sunlight and kept out of the sight and reach of children

Medicines should not be disposed off via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose off medicines no longer required. These measures will help protect the environment.

What Coldamol contains

The active substances in Coldamol is Chlorpheniramine maleate, Caffeine anhydrous, Pseudoephedrine HCl and Paracetamol.
