### TROGYL PREPARATIONS:

{METRONIDAZOLE}

*Read this leaflet carefully before you start taking this medicine.*

- This medicine has been prescribed for your current medical problem only. It must not be given to other people or used for other problems unless you are otherwise directed by your doctor.
- In order that this medicine works, it must be taken exactly as directed.
- Keep all medicines out of reach of children.
- If you want more information about this medicine ask your doctor or pharmacist.

#### 1. WHAT IS TROGYL AND WHAT IS IT USED FOR?

The name of the medicine is TrogyL. The active ingredients is Metronidazole which is a 5-nitroimidazole derivative with activity against anaerobic protozoa and anaerobic bacteria. If you need any further information on your illness, speak to your doctor.

Each tablet contains: Metronidazole 200mg/tablet.

Each tablet contains: Metronidazole 400mg/tablet.

Each 5mls contain Metronidazole 200mg/5mls

#### 2. BEFORE YOU USE:

*Do not use TrogyL without medical advice:*

- If you have had an allergy to any of the ingredients in the past.
- If you are on any other drugs.

#### 3. HOW TO USE TROGYL:

**Adults:** 400mg three times daily

The length of treatment will depend on the illness being treated and it is important to finish the full course of treatment.

**Children:** less than 12years 20-30mg/kg

Your doctor will work out how much your child should take depending on their weight

#### 4. POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS:

*Like all medicines, TrogyL can have side effects though not everyone gets them.*

-Swelling of the hands, lips, face, stomach pains, coloured urine, headaches, muscle/joint, furred tongue, fever, nausea and vomiting.

*Report this or any other side effects to your doctor or pharmacist.*

#### 5. HOW TO STORE TROGYL:

*Do not use TrogyL after the expiry date stamped on the pack.*

*The expiry date refers to the last day of the month.*

TrogyL should be stored in a cool place below 30°C, protected from direct sunlight and kept out of the sight and reach of children

Medicines should not be disposed off via wastewater or household waste. Ask your pharmacist how to dispose off medicines no longer required. These measures will help protect the environment.

The active substances in TrogyL is metronidazole.
