1 WHAT IS CANDIMALE CREAM AND WHAT IS IT USED FOR

Candimale cream is used for Preventive measure to avoid transfer of infection, Candidial balanitis and Balanitis due to Trichomoniasis, other bacterial infections.

CANDIMALE Cream is used for the treatment of fungal and bacterial infection. It is also recommended to treat certain infections after surgery.

2. WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW BEFORE YOU TAKE CANDIMALE CREAM

Do not take Candimale Cream if you are allergic to any of the contents.

Sometimes drugs are not safe when you take them with certain other drugs and food. - Taking them together can cause bad side effects. - Be sure to talk to your doctor about all the drugs you take.

3. HOW TO TAKE CANDIMALE CREAM

1. For Preventive use.

Apply 'Candimale Cream' to the whole area of penis before and after intercourse or as directed by your Physician.

2. Balanitis

Apply 'Candimale Cream' to the lesions twice daily. Rub the medication gently.

If you take more Candimale Cream than you should

It is important not to take doses. If you have taken more than you should, contact your doctor, pharmacist or nearest hospital casualty department immediately.

If you forget to take Candimale Cream

If you forget to take your tablets, take it as soon as you remember, unless it is nearly time for your next dose, do not take the dose you have missed. Do not take a double the dose to make up for a forgotten dose.

4. POSSIBLE SIDE EFFECTS

Topical application of 'Candimale Cream' is excellently tolerated.

5. HOW TO STORE CANDIMALE CREAM

Store at temperature below 25° C. Do not freeze.

Keep medicines out of reach of children.

Candimale cream must not be used after the expiry date.

6. CONTENTS OF THE PACK AND OTHER INFORMATION

What Candimale cream contains

The active substance is Miconazole USP and ornidazole.

The other ingredients are Propylene Glycol BP, Cetomacragol 1000 BP, Cetostearyl Alcohol BP, Olivem 700, Hard Paraffin BP, White Soft Paraffin BP, Propylparaben BP, Methylparaben BP, Butylated Hydroxytoluene BP, Lemon Oil, Orange Oil (5 Folds), Citric Acid Monohydrate BP, Purified Water BP

What Candimale Cream look like and contents of the pack

White to off white coloured cream with pleasant odour
