- This medicine has been prescribed for you. Do not pass it on to others. It may harm them, even if their symptoms are the same as yours.
- If any of the side effects gets serious, or if you notice any side effects not listed in this leaflet, please tell your doctor or pharmacist.

#### **1. What CYPROL Syrup is and what they are used for**

CYPROL Syrup is a medicine that is used for the treatment of Allergies, Sneezing, Watery eyes, Itching and runny nose, Loss of appetite, Migraine and vascular headache and other conditions.

CYPROL Syrup contains Cyproheptadine and L-Lysine as active ingredients.

CYPROL Syrup works by blocking the action of histamine; enhancing effect on viral replication;

#### **2. Before you take CYPROL Syrup.**

Before using this drug, inform your doctor about your current list of medications, over the counter products (e.g. vitamins, herbal supplements, etc.), allergies, pre-existing diseases, and current health conditions (e.g. pregnancy, upcoming surgery, etc.). Some health conditions may make you more susceptible to the side effects of the drug. Take as directed by your doctor or follow the direction printed on the product insert. Dosage is based on your condition. Tell your doctor if your condition persists or worsens. Important counseling points are listed below.

- Avoid drinking alcohol as it can increase certain side effects
- Consult your doctor before taking this medicine if you are pregnant
- Do not start or continue the drug without consulting
- Do not take this medicine while you are breastfeeding
- If you are allergic to it or any of the other ingredients
- If you are taking other medicines such as antihistamines or monoamine-oxidase inhibitor.

### **3. How to take CYPROL Syrup?**

5 ml (1 Teaspoon full) two to three times a day.

### **4. Possible side effects.**

The following is a list of possible side effects that may occur from all constituting ingredients of CYPROL Syrup. This is not a comprehensive list. These side effects are possible, but do not always occur. Some of the side effects may be rare but serious. Consult your doctor if you observe any of the following side effects, especially if they do not go away.

- Disturbed coordination
- Restlessness
- Irritability
- Blurred vision
- Inflammation of nerves
- Nausea

### **5. How to store CYPROL Syrup?**

- Store medicines at room temperature, away from heat and direct light. Do not freeze medicines unless required by package insert. Keep medicines away from children. Store below 30°C in dark place. Do not freeze
- Do not flush medications down the toilet or pour them into drainage unless instructed to do so. Medication discarded in this manner may contaminate the environment. Please consult your pharmacist or doctor for more details on how to safely discard CYPROL Syrup.

The inactive ingredients in the syrup are Sucrose BP, Propylene Glycol BP, Methyl Hydroxybenzoate BP, Propyl Hydroxybenzoate BP, Saccharin BP, Sodium Benzoate BP, Essence Mixed Fruit Flavour IHS, Disodium Edetate BP, Riboflavin Sodium Phosphate BP & Purified Water BP.
